## **Health Centre Update**

The Clydebank Health and Care Centre has taken a major, positive step forward, with the project achieving financial close on the 10<sup>th</sup> December 2019. With this milestone now complete, the contractor started on site to commence their 18 month construction programme on the 27<sup>th</sup> January 2020. The contractor has begun mobilization and preparation of the ground works, and will quickly commence the construction of the substructure. It is a very exciting time for the Clydebank Health and Care Centre and the wider Queen's Quay development as we start work on the second major development in the area.



The team behind the project are working hard to ensure that they deliver the best possible Health and Care provision for the residents of Clydebank. Currently the team are involving the wider user groups of the building to help pick the interior decoration and implement the Art Strategy that covers both the Health and Care Centre and Care Home.

## Clydebank's New £14m Care Home at Queen's Quay





The new Clydebank Care Home is sited in the heart of the new Queen's Quay Masterplan, and combined with the new Clydebank Health and Care Centre together they complete the Queen's Quay Health Quarter. The new home will provide modern, comfortable accommodation for 84 residents, and provide a Day Services Centre for 50 visitors per session. The Queen's Quay Health Quarter will play a crucial part in improving health and care in the community.

Each resident will have their own en-suite bedroom, and each bedroom will be within a 10 bedroom flat, sharing a lounge/dining area and separate sitting room. There are 8 flats within the care home 7 of which have 10 bedrooms and 1 larger flat has 14 bedrooms.

To compliment the living accommodation, the home has a variety of social spaces. The main social hub will include a 20 person cinema, a bistro and a hair salon. In addition to this the home will also include other social spaces:

- A community growing garden, with raised beds and allotments.
- Four courtyards with differing themes; Sculpture, Activity, Water and Sensory to provide residents with multiple ways to use and enjoy outdoor space within a safe environment.
- Three multipurpose rooms for flexible activity space.
- A sensory room for relaxation, health and wellbeing.
- An art studio with a large north facing terrace adjacent, and neighbouring art gallery.

We have consulted with our residents and their families, HSCP staff, Elected Members and the wider Clydebank community for a name for the new care home, a short list has been voted on and the name will be announced soon. The building is currently under construction by CCG ltd and is two thirds of the way through it's 18 month construction programme. The building is due to be handed over to WDHSCP summer 2020. WDHSCP will be delighted to welcome it's first residents to the home around 2 months later, after a transition period for training, testing and commissioning.









## What's Happening on Queen's Quay Site?

## **Energy Centre Update**

The Energy Centre has been designed to create an attractive feature within Queen's Quay, complementing the historic Titan Crane. The Energy Centre will use 'Water Source Heat Pumps' to extract water and heat from the River Clyde, giving the District Heating Network a direct link to natural resources. The Energy Centre will generate heat which will be pumped through 2,500m of district heating pipes connecting local housing, businesses and public buildings.

Water source heat pumps work by running a low-temperature refrigerant fluid in heat exchanger coils through a constant heat source, such as the River Clyde. The fluid absorbs this heat and boils, even at temperatures below 0 °C. The resulting gas is then compressed, which further increases its temperature. The gas is passed into heat exchanger coils, where it condenses, releasing its latent heat. This is the same process that is used to extract heat from a fridge. Water-source heat pumps require a suitable local water source, making the Queen's Quay development an ideal location for the new facility.

The Energy Centre is nearing the end of its construction and commissioning period and will be producing heat for our new care in time for residents moving in Summer 2020.
